Teaching

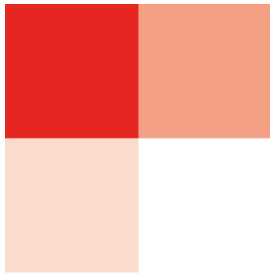
- Full-time, part-time, and cooperative education to French and foreign students

- PhD in management science (dissertation must be defended before Jun. 30, 2023, and any defense pre-reports must be provided at the interview)
- Ability to teach in French and English
- High potential for publication in national and international academic journals
- Willingness to coordinate full-time or part-time degrees/specializations, such as a master's degree, MBA, or equivalent, offered by the School
