YOUR PROFILE

Basic requirements:

- PhD in management science (dissertation must be defended before Jun. 30, 2023, and any defense prereports must be provided at the interview)
- Ability to teach in French and English
- High potential for publication in national and international academic journals
- Willingness to coordinate full-time or part-time degrees/specializations, such as a master's degree, MBA, or equivalent, offered by the School

Assets:

- Interest in innovative teaching methods
- Ability to teach in a third language
- Expertise in accounting/control/corporate finance, marketing/digital marketing/sales, supply chain management/purchasing, management/human resources, or strategy/entrepreneurship/project management



















APPLICATION PROCEDURE

Candidates must submit a job application addressed to the President of the University of Strasbourg, which will be accessible to the selection committee. This application form includes a digital version of the following documents:

- identity document with a photo;
- proof of possession of a doctorate or habilitation to direct research. State doctorates, post-graduate doctorates and engineering doctorates are accepted as equivalent to doctorates;
- an analytical presentation of works, books, articles, achievements and activities, mentioning those that the candidate intends to present at the audition;
- a copy of each of the works, articles and achievements mentioned in the analytical presentation and which the candidate intends to present at the audition;
- the diploma defense report, if applicable;
- a cover letter including the contact details of 2 referees.

Any application incomplete by the above-mentioned deadline will be declared inadmissible.
