TWO DOCTORAL CONTRACTS (M/F)

EM Strasbourg Business School, the only French management school aligned with the international model of a business school integrated into an academic center of excellence—the University of Strasbourg—aims to strengthen its support policy for young researchers.

As part of this initiative, it is offering two doctoral contracts starting from the 2025/2026 academic year.

Doctoral research will align with the research themes of the LaRGE (UR 2364) and HuManiS (UR 7308) laboratories of the Augustin Cournot Doctoral School at the University of Strasbourg and will be supervised by a qualified faculty member authorized to direct researches.

The doctoral student will be required to carry out an additional one-year teaching or expertise assignment, renewable twice, and paid through an adjunct teaching contract.

Applicants must hold a Master's degree (Research or Professional).

The offered contract is a fixed-term (CDD) 3-year position. The doctoral student will have an office at EM Strasbourg Business School and must reside in Strasbourg for the duration of the contract.

A CV, a cover letter, a thesis project of at least 10 pages (see thesis project template), Transcript of grades from the Master 2 program and a recommendation letter* from a member of the LaRGE or HuManiS laboratory.

***This letter must be written by a University Professor or a researcher authorized to direct researches, and must express their willingness to supervise your thesis.*
